

BUNDABERG NORTH STATE SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Bundaberg North State school is a 'uniform' school.

Statement of Intent

The purposes of our uniform are to:

- identify students within our school community
- remove the competitive element associated with dress and fashion
- ensure that non-Bundaberg North State School visitors are quickly and easily identified by staff

FOOTWEAR

Shoes

Departmental instructions on safety procedures adopted by all schools in Queensland clearly state that feet must be covered.

Students must wear black, lace-up or Velcro enclosed shoes that fully cover the entire foot at all times, including to the ankle.

In accordance with Department of Education (Queensland) safety requirements, footwear must provide appropriate protection and ensure that students' feet are fully covered while at school.

*Canvas or fabric slip on shoes, ballet slipper style shoes, thongs, sandals, open weave or mesh shoes, boots, coloured shoes with coloured trim, logos or coloured laces are **NOT** permitted. **EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE SHOES** - Shoes must be **BLACK** only, with black laces or Velcro.*



The following footwear does not meet departmental safety requirements and is not permitted:

EXAMPLES OF UNACCEPTABLE SHOES

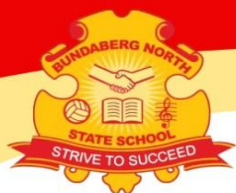


NOTE: Students with an injured foot must wear closed-in footwear on the 'good' foot.

Socks

- White only with no other colour (including stripes)
- Must be visible above the cuff of the shoe but no more than mid-calf





HATS & HEADWEAR

Students must wear a hat whenever they are exposed to the sun. Hats are worn for sun protection, and students are expected to always keep a hat in their school bag.

Prep students will be provided with a coloured bucket hat at the time of enrolment; the cost of this hat is covered by the school.

All other students are required to have a black sun-safe hat of their own choice. The Bundaberg North State School bucket hat is the preferred option.

Bundaberg North hats are reversible, with a sports house colour on the inside. The coloured side is to be worn only during sporting events.

No form of headwear is permitted to be worn in classrooms, except for subtle hair ties/bands. Headwear for cultural reasons is to be negotiated with the Principal.

JEWELLERY & PIERCINGS

Jewellery is limited to one ring (which cannot present a potential hazard to other students), a watch, and up to two small studs or sleepers in each ear. Spacers, tapers, bracelets, cosmetic contact lenses and visible necklaces are not permitted. Tattoos (temporary or permanent), facial and visible body piercings are **NOT permitted**.

SMARTWATCHES AND WEARABLE DEVICES

Smartwatches and other wearable devices are considered **mobile devices** under the Department of Education (Queensland) *Student use of mobile devices procedure*.

Students may wear smartwatches at school, but all notifications must be turned off during the school day or set to school mode. Smartwatches are not to be used for communication, recording, or internet access at school unless an approved exemption is in place.

NOTE: Medical alert bracelets are acceptable.

MAKE-UP & HAIR COLOUR

Only neutral hair colouring and clear nail polish are permitted. No false nails, make-up, false eyelashes or hair colour is permitted.

UNIFORM OPTIONS

YEARS PREP-6 POLO SHIRT

- A red polo shirt with gold and black trimmings with School Emblem (sleeves are not to be rolled up)
- Senior's polo shirt- (Year 6 only)



BLACK SHORTS, SKORTS or SKIRT

- Plain black school shorts, skorts or a skirt.
- Options include formal shorts **OR** sports shorts which need to be loose-fitting -NO MESH, DENIM, BOARD OR JEAN shorts are to be worn.
- All shorts, skorts or Skirts are to be of **appropriate length and coverage**.

SPORTS HOUSE SHIRTS

- Green, Yellow and Blue sports polo shirts can be worn at sports events (including Athletics Carnival).

NOTE: Underwear is not to be visible.



WINTER UNIFORM – SAME AS SUMMER UNIFORM WITH THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS

- Students may wear tights and/or long plain black leggings under their shorts or skirt in the winter months.
- Plain black tracksuit or black slacks may be worn. Tracksuit pants and slacks are not to be rolled up
- Plain black jumper or jacket.
- No other jumpers or jackets are permitted.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

Should the dress of students not comply with the safety regulations set down for certain subjects and activities, those students will be refused entry in those areas, and other relevant work will be provided in a supervised environment.
